R.E.A.L is a set of expectations and hopes that we have for our church. These are not expectations of someone *in order to be a part* of our church, but rather what we would expect for someone *because they are a part* of our church.

Our desire is to position ourselves for the formative work of the Spirit.

R-ELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST

We want for everyone to have a PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP with Christ.

E-NGAGED IN COMMUNITY

We want for everyone to be VITALLY CONNECTED to the Body of Christ.

A-CTIVE IN SERVING

We want for everyone to have a sense of SHARED RESPONSIBILITY for our church.

L-EVERAGE YOUR LIFE FOR IMPACT

We want for everyone to FULFILL THEIR CALLING.

DEFINITION OF LEVERAGE

Leverage is what God does we make anything we have available for anything He wants.
